Treści modułu kształcenia (z podziałem na formy realizacji zajęć)	<p>The course will focus on conversation, discussion and reading. The students will be required to read 4 or 5 articles about some aspects of Taiwan in the class, such as society, custom, education, history...etc. The articles will be from easy to difficult, so the first text is the easiest for students to learn and other texts will be more difficult and longer than the previous one. For example, the first article is about night markets in Taiwan. The length of the text is not long and the grammar is not very complex; the last article is about Taiwan community and language which also introduces the history of Taiwan. The grammar and the text will be more complex and longer. However, the instructor will provide additional materials like the video or pictures to extend the scope of discussion no matter the articles are easy or complicated because the texts are served as the points. In order to understand the texts, the instructor will take 3-4 hours to teach vocabulary and grammar for each article. Then, another 3-4 hours will be for reading and discussion. The students will be required to use the vocabulary and structures what they learned in class to discuss. For instance, one of the articles is Taiwan's religious and folk festivals. The students will learn the vocabulary in the text: 燒香(shāoxiāng)、拜拜(bàibài)、寺廟(sìmiào)、迷信(míxìn), but they will also get supplementary material to know 道教(dàojiào)、佛教(fójiào)、媽祖(māzǔ)、觀音(guānyīn) which are related to the theme. These words the students have to use when they express their opinions or compare the differences between Taiwan and Poland. Hence, the assignments will let the learners do the vocabulary and grammar practices. The form includes multiple choices, fill in blanks, complete the sentences, and reading.</p> <p>The course will help the students to recognize traditional Chinese characters because people will see the traditional characters in daily life no matter they go to Taiwan or Hong Kong, Besides, young people in mainland China now are encouraged to know traditional characters even if they do not know how to write and people will find something that are presented in</p>

	<p>tradition Chinese characters, especially in temples and historical sites. In fact, it is not difficult to learn how to recognize traditional Chinese characters. The instructor will take 30 - 40 minutes to introduce students the basic rules of recognizing traditional characters in the first class in order to develop the conception. The teacher will also give the list of the rules for recognizing characters to the learners who can practice /review outside of the classroom. Then, the students will be taught to recognize step by step and from time to time when they start reading the textbook because both simplifies characters and traditional Chinese characters are used in the textbook. To learn effectively, the students will do the homework to practice recognizing, such as matching and multiple choices. In addition, all assignments and tests will be presented in traditional characters; nevertheless, the students can only use simplifies characters to answer. The course only requires the learners to recognize traditional Chinese characters which the students will not be required to write.</p> <p>In order to promote effective learning, the teacher utilizes communicative methods in instruction. The students will gain knowledge easily and naturally in a Chinese environment.</p>
